## Rod Wynne-Powell

SOLUTIONS Photographic was originally a doubleentendre to link photographic chemistry and problemsolving. The consultancy side of the business began when he was sales manager of a London color laboratory, where many calls he received began with the words: 'Rod, I've got a problem...' Prior to his time in the Lab, he had been a commercial/industrial photographer.

His attention to detail and dogged determination led some developers to accept his offers to beta test their graphics products. This gave him the opportunity to fashion these to meet the requirements of retouchers and manipulators, giving his clients an edge against their competitors. It allowed him to offer in-depth training very early in the product life cycle, and gain insights into the developers' future direction.

Speaking the same language as photographers has enabled him to guide others past the problems that might ensnare them when entering the digital world. He offers help from the basics of Mac housekeeping (Mac OS 9.x and Mac OS X), its interface, and fault diagnostics, through to the far more enjoyable aspects of teaching techniques for the productive and creative use of Photoshop as a montaging and retouching tool. His help has been valued and respected amongst digital photographers, several of whom have engaged him alongside them in their studios, thus allowing them greater creative control over the output of their work. An added bonus has been his ability to pass on his skills whilst their job proceeds.
